Sealed bids for construction of the Phase 2 Rehabilitation of E.J. Delaney WTP Project, Bid / Contract No. 2010-25, for the Town of Walpole, Massachusetts, will be received at the Purchasing Office, Room 118, 135 School Street, Walpole, MA 02081 until 11:00 AM prevailing time, on Thursday February 25, 2010 at which time and place said bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work includes removing the existing dehumidifier and associated ductwork and furnishing and installing the new dehumidifier and drain line.

The contract duration is 115 consecutive calendar days.

Bid Security in the form of a bid bond, cash, certified check, treasurer's or cashier's check payable to the Owner, is required in the amount of five percent of the bid, in accordance with the conditions in Section 00200, INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

The Instructions to Bidders, Form of General Bid, Agreement, Plans, Specifications, Performance and Payment Bond, and other Contract Documents may be examined at the following:

Copies may be obtained at the Town of Walpole Purchasing Office, Room 118 (508-660-7290), 135 School St., Walpole, MA, Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 8 AM to 4 PM, Tuesday from 8 AM to 8 PM, and Friday from 8 AM to 12 PM, upon payment of \$50 for each set. Any unsuccessful bidder or nonbidder, upon returning such set within the time specified in the Instructions to Bidders and in good condition, will be refunded his payment.

Contract Documents and plans will be mailed to prospective bidders upon request and receipt of a separate check for \$25 to cover handling and mailing fees. This amount is not refundable.

Both checks shall be made payable to Town of Walpole, MA and reference Project No. 2010-25.

The selected contractor shall furnish a performance bond and a payment bond in amount at least equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price as stipulated in Section 00700, GENERAL CONDITIONS of these specifications.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of the Division of Occupational Safety of the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce Development under the provisions of the

Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Bidder, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

The Bidder agrees that this bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 working days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded after the opening of bids.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.
