EMA Disbursements: Voted to confirm the recommendations of the WEMAF Review Committee for the months of November and December, 2018 and January and February, 2019. The Town Finance Director was instructed to make the following payments from the Emergency Medical Aid Fund.

Walpole Emergency Medical Aid Fund (WEMAF): We are continuing to research and investigate our outreach effort to attract more financially need clients

We resolved in part to accelerate our outreach efforts. John Sheehan contacted a local artist who helped craft a logo, letterhead, and a pamphlet that could be distributed.
